2) 'Ali Uşki 34v/68. 1 = \downarrow . The title is given as *şükûfezâr nazîresi*.

H1 a 1: 5-6 A, 2: 1-2 A g ($\downarrow \uparrow$), 4: 2-3 de d, 4 cBd. There is no repeat after 4, but H1 a and b are repeated as a unit.

H1 b 2: 1-2 bd a ($\downarrow \uparrow$), 3-4 g f#, 3: 1 cf#, 4 *seconda volta*: 7-8 e.

M a 2: 4 cBd, 7 Bd. M a is written as 4 cycles to be repeated, *prima volta* as 4, *seconda volta* as 8 except: 6 e, 7-8 d.

M b 2: 3,4 d, 5 cBd, 3: 8 c, 6: 3,4 cf(?)4, 7,8 de, 8: 1-2 d e ($\downarrow \uparrow$), 4 cBd, 8 Bd. M b is written as 9 cycles to be repeated, *prima volta* as 9 except: 2 cBd.

1) M b 17: 1 *d* is clear, but could be a slip for *Bd*.

2) M b is written as 9 cycles to be repeated, *seconda volta* as 18 except: 2 c*Bd*, 7-8 e.

M c 4: 1 *d*, 2 c*Bd*, 7-8 *prima volta*: e.

H 2 b 1: 3,4 f*Hd*, 4: 7-8 *prima volta*: a, *seconda volta*: e.

H 3 a 2: 1 A.

H 3 b: for *Bd* 'Ali Uşki has cb. 4: 7-8 *seconda volta*: e.

H 3 c 2: 7-8 *seconda volta*: e.

3) Sanal 227-8. 1 = $\text{D}^{\#}$. Suggested tempo $\text{J} = 256$.

In H3 b and c the modulations are not indicated, both subsections being given the same mode signature as H3 a.
