



- 1) There is a following comment, serhäne müläzime hükmindedir ('H1 functions as M'), suggesting that the designation M is redundant (being equivalent to H1 b). Some support for this interpretation of the formal structure of the piece may be drawn from the fact that in the 'Ali Ufki version the müläzime starts at H1 5.
- 2) 'Alı Ulki 131r/246, 1 = 1,

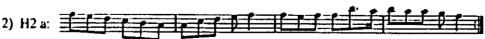
