

1) The piece of which this is the nazīre is not included in the collection.

M a 1: 3 c'bd might be preferred in the light of both 3 and the 'Ali Ufki version.

2) 'Ali Ufki 1571/284. 1 = J. The composer is named as Kemáni Mustafa.

H1 a 1: 3,10 c'bb, 2: 1-7 and 3: 1-7 arc omitted, 3: 9-10 c Bd, 12 A.



M a 1: 3 c'bd. 1-4 are written as two cycles to be repeated, 2: 11-14 prima volta: eff ga fig a, seconda volta: e, 5: 1 cc, 8 Bdb, 12 A.



- 1) H3 a 3: 7 db (ص) is clear, but Bd (س) might be preferred in the light of H3 b 3: 7.
- 2) Mb 1: 5 ec, 6-7 c Bd, 8-10 ABd A Bd, 12 cBd, 14 c, 2: 1 cc.
- M c 1: 3 Bd, 5 cBd, 6-7 A G, 12 Bd, 14 c. 2 is omitted, but there is a repeat sign after 1. 3: 6-7 c Bd, 8 cdb. 3 is to be repeated.
- 112 a 1: 8-2: 7 has the same melodic contour, but set one tone higher. 2: 8-9 c'bd'c', 12 bdg.
- H2 b:
- H3 a 2: 1 (? erroneously) cklh, 11-12 Bd A ($\sqrt{}$), 3: 7Bd, 8-10 cBd Bd A. 1 is to be repeated. There is then a double bar but no repeat sign after 3.
- H3 b: Corresponding to 1 and 2 is:
- 3: 8-10 cBd Bd A. There is no repeat sign after 3.
- 3) *Ezgi 1, 157-9 (and thence Arcl, 104 (H1 a only)). 1=J. Time signature 28: 4. Ezgi: suggested tempo J=96. The composer is named as Osman Dede (Arel: Kutbu-nåyl Osman Dede). (H1 a>H1, H1 b>M, M>H2, H2 + H3 a 1,2>H3, H3 b>(H4].)
