1) In place of H2 is ve leh, suggesting therefore that what is identified here as H2 is rather a further subsection of the mūlâzime (M d). That this is clearly a slip is shown by the fact that the next hane is identified as H3. That H2 consists of only a single subsection is confirmed by the 'Ali Ulķī version.
