


1) 111 8: the arrow marks the point at which the testim material, similarly identified, commences, testim: the heading in full is bāzgū testīm (repeat the testim [material]).
M b: the internal repetition is indicated by the term mükerrer.





1) Z: normally this section occurs twice, after H2 and H3, but here it occurs unexpectedly after M as well. One may consider this the result of the same material having two functions: as Z after H2 and H3, and also simply as the final subsection of M (=M c), for since the finalis of gevest, Bd, is found not in M b but in Z, Z should presumably also appear at the end of M each time it recurs.

testim 1: 4-5 ft. Only 1 is given, and the transcription then continues immediately with M b.

M b: -2. 5: 3 /h.

Z 1: 3 /4.

Z: only 1 is given.

H3 b 2: 4-5 c', 6 db' 1.

H3 c 2,6: 6 a J.

H3 d 5: 4 g.

Z: only 1 (: 1-2f) is given.
